Call for papers:

Re-thinking Lifescape: Linking Landscape to Everyday Life

Deadline for abstracts: 31st May 2015

We experience ordinary places and environments every day. Lifescape, landscape in everyday life, is a precondition for existence as well as a background for living. We, however, seldom notice its values because of the veil of familiarity. By rethinking lifescape, we can evoke values not typically associated with cultural landscapes and heritages. Lifescape is experienced everywhere in both urban and rural landscapes, such as the landscape of the CBD, market place, country-side, and farmland. Although this conference mainly addresses rethinking lifescape, we also have a special sub-theme on island landscape, which have seen its popularity rise as a tourism destination. The sub-theme includes topics such as unique rural landscape, sacred places and landscapes of folk religion, and stone landscapes.

Conference Theme: *Re-thinking Lifescape: Linking Landscape to Everyday Life*

The International Symposium will explore and discuss the theme under four sub-themes briefly illustrated below.

Theme 1: New Ideas and Theories of Cultural Landscape

- New concepts and ideas as a way of seeing
- Methodology
- Value evaluation
- Aesthetics
- Place attachment and identity
- Collective memory and place, etc.

Theme 2: Strategies and Plans on Conservation and Management

- Management and conservation strategies
- Plans for sustainability
- Living landscape and tourism
- Governance and local movements
- Economical solutions, Laws, etc.

Theme 3: Cases and Experiences

- Public parks, gardens and green infrastructure
- Urban landscapes and ordinary places
- Historic landscapes and cultural heritages
- Local identity and vernacular landscapes, etc.

Theme 4: Special Topic - Island Landscape

- Sacred places and landscapes of folk religion
- Unique rural landscapes in the island
- Stone landscapes in the island
- Climate and landscape in the island
- Coastal landscapes, people in landscape, etc.

Author Guidelines

Paper submission and review process are conducted in the following manner:

To propose a paper for one of the four sub-themes, please submit a concise one page abstract (max. 300 words including 3-5 keywords), in English, by email to *icomos2015jeju@gmail.com* by 31 May 2015.

The abstracts should include:

- The full title of the paper
- The selected sub-theme
- Three to five keywords that reflect the general theme of the paper
- The author's name(s), institutional affiliation and contact details (postal address, phone, fax, email)
- If you are an ICOMOS member, your ICOMOS National Committee and membership number
(as mentioned on your membership card)

No more than one abstract per author will be considered (unless for the second abstract you are not the principal author). Proposals will be selected through blind peer-review by the International Scientific Committee of the Symposium and categorized by sub-theme. The authors of the selected proposals will be informed by 6 July 2015. Authors will submit the full paper in 31 August 2015. The length of each paper should not be longer than 12 pages(A4 size; 5,000 words) following the format given in the paper template. Submitted papers will be reviewed by experts in their respective research fields selected by the International Scientific Committee. The abstract and the full-length paper must be saved as Microsoft Word and sent electronically. Selected oral presenters should submit final presentation in Microsoft Power Point or PDF format.
